# Prescription Savings Program Details

- WPA Prescription Savings is a comprehensive program that utilizes a network of prescription resources to find members the lowest price available on their prescription medications
- Prescription resources which WPA Specialists utilize include:
  - Pharmaceutical Manufacturer (PAP) (Prescription Advocacy Programs)
  - Mail Order Pharmacies
  - Discount Cards
  - Generic Costs at members local pharmacies / Pharmacy cards
- WPA Specialists will work on the member's behalf to provide a Prescription Savings Cost Analysis of their available savings over the phone
- If WPA member is eligible for a pharmaceutical manufacturer PAP Program, WPA charges a reasonable administrative fee starting at just \$25 a month per medication.
- WPA members have complimentary Prescription Advocacy service on ALL Generic prescription medications

# How Does it Work?

## How do we help?

- We find pharmaceutical manufacturer Patient Assistance Programs (PAPs), determine client eligibility, and complete all necessary enrollment administrative duties
- We work directly with physicians offices to obtain, verify, and confirm prescriptions
- We work directly with pharmacies to price shop and compare the clients prescription medications in order for WPA to provide the best possible pricing
- We research all available RX savings opportunities which may include discount cards, mail order pharmacies, local pharmacies, coupons, and generics
- We provide clients with a 90 day **Prescription Savings Guarantee** where we complete another Prescription Savings Cost Analysis to make sure they are getting the best pricing possible, we re-order their medications, and re-submit any files which may be required by manufacturer programs (PAPs).

## Who do we help?

- Individuals 18 and over, families, and seniors

  - \$25 monthly service charge for one eligible PAP medication
  - \$45 monthly service charge for two or more eligible PAP medications (unlimited)
- **PSP Includes:**
  - WPA acting as a comprehensive prescription advocate for clients and WPA must obtain signed T&C's & prescriptions from Doctors
  - WPA will complete all PAP administration and if available any additional /general savings administration
  - WPA will work directly with proper pharmacies to call in any prescriptions for client pick-up
  - Includes 90 day Prescription Savings Guarantee

## PSL Prescription Savings Lite

- **Qualification:** *Annual RX savings of \$1200+*
- **Administrative Fee:**
  - One time \$25 set-up fee & \$9.99 Monthly service fee for General Savings Assistance
- **General Savings Include:**
  - Coupons
  - Mail Order
  - Local Pharmacies
  - Discount Drug Cards
  - Generic options
  - Walmart PBM Savings Card
- **PSL Includes:**
  - WPA acting as a comprehensive prescription advocate for clients and WPA must obtain signed T&C's, & Prescriptions from Doctors
  - WPA will complete all PAP administration and if available any additional /general savings administration
  - WPA will work directly with proper pharmacies to call in any prescriptions for client pick-up
  - Includes 90 day Prescription Savings Guarantee

## PSS Prescription Savings Service

- **Qualification:** *Annual RX savings over \$175 & less than \$1200*
- **Administrative Fee:**
  - One time \$75 Service Fee
- **PSS Includes:**
  - Findings of general savings handed off to client

# FAQ's

## Q: What is a Patient Assistance Program?

A: Patient Assistance Programs are run by pharmaceutical companies to aid uninsured, low income Americans in receiving free or low-cost prescription medications. Most major drug companies have patient assistance programs and name brand drugs that are often prescribed by doctors are typically available.

## Q: Who is eligible for PAPs?

A: Each pharmaceutical manufacturer has its own eligibility requirements. In most cases, you can get help from a patient assistance program if:

- You are a US citizen who is uninsured or has a financial hardship
- You can't afford your medication and or current mail order
- You take a medication not covered by your insurance or you are taking a complex medication
- Your household income is between 0% - 300% of the posted Federal Poverty Guidelines, see 2014 FPG chart below
  - For some medications eligibility is as high as 500% of Federal Poverty Guidelines **or has no income limits.**
